



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CHILDRENS ART CONTEST “DIBUJA ARGENTINA”

The Consulate General of the Argentine Republic in Sydney, together with the associations and representatives of the Argentine and Latin American community in Australia, is pleased to announce an art contest for boys and girls, who are between 6 and 12 years old.

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this event is to evoke the vision that each participant has about the Argentine Republic: to develop their own and individual imagination about the country. It must be an original work that captures the unique worldview of each participant.

CATEGORIES

There will be 2 categories, divided by age. Each participant in each category may present up to one work.

Category 1: Participants from 6 to 8 years old.

Category 2: Participants from 9 to 12 years old.

THEME

The theme this year will be places in Argentina. We propose this year that participants draw a place in Argentina that they have visited or are interested in visiting. It can be a tourist place in a city or town, an emblematic building or a natural landscape.

TECHNIQUE

Open to all techniques. This implies that each participant can use different methods to make their creation: brushes, spatula, their own hands or any other method that they like.

MATERIALS

Open to any materials. This implies that each participant can use different materials to make their creation: acrylics, tempera paints, brushes, pencils, crayons, markers or any other method that they like. The work must be printed on a surface no larger than an A4 page (210 × 297 mm).

DELIVERY

The works of art must be sent by mail to the Office of the Consulate General of the Argentine Republic in Sydney, PO Box Q1613, QVB Post Office, NSW 1230, Australia. They can also be delivered in person at the headquarters of the Argentine Consulate General (Level 20, 44 Market St, Sydney, NSW) from Monday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. The works must be sent signed with a pseudonym and indicating the age and category (CATEGORY ONE/CATEGORY TWO) in which they will be participating. Inside the package, a sealed envelope should be included with the artwork which contains inside the



name, telephone number and email of the tutor and the name of the participating boy/girl. A photocopy of the minor's Argentine DNI, ID, and/or passport or other documentation proving their date of birth must also be included in the envelope.

DATES

The call will be open from October 18 to November 22, 2024 inclusive, days between which the works must be received.

JURY

The Consulate General of the Argentine Republic in Sydney will form a jury made up of three plastic artists from the jurisdiction, who will be in charge of reviewing, evaluating and ruling on the awards for each category. The jury's decision will be final.

EVALUATION

Once the delivery period has ended, the Jury will select TWO drawings from each category, to which the first and second prizes will be awarded. The winners will be notified starting December 2, 2024 by email, and will be invited to the awards ceremony.

Every participant will receive a certificate for their participation.

AWARDS

The awards ceremony will take place on December 6, 2024 at the Consulate General of the Argentine Republic in Sydney (20th Floor, 44 Market Street, Sydney) at a time to be determined and all contest participants and their families will be invited.

Winners and/or participants of the competition who do not reside in NSW and cannot attend the awards ceremony may receive their recognition diplomas and/or the corresponding prizes to their respective addresses via postal mail.

- **ALL PARTICIPANTS**
 - Certificate of recognition for your participation in the “Dibuja Argentina” Contest by the Argentine Consulate in Sydney.
- **FIRST PLACE IN EACH CATEGORY**
 - Jersey of the Argentine national football team.
 - Artistic product kit
- **SECOND PLACE IN EACH CATEGORY**
 - Children's book by an Argentine author.
 - Artistic product kit

COMPETITION RULES

- Girls and boys residing in Australia between 6 and 12 years old as of October 1, 2024 can participate.
- Each participant may present up to one piece of artwork.

- Direct family members of employees of the Argentine Consulate General will not be able to participate.
- The parents and/or guardians of the participating boys or girls expressly authorize the Consulate of the Argentine Republic in Sydney to display the drawings presented in this contest and to publish them on social networks and the consulate's website citing the name of the children.
